“Live Earth and the ACLU”

Listen to what one expert climatologist says on the subject. 25 Jun 07 - "Dr. Richard Lindzen is one of the original deniers – (of a looming disaster) and among the first to criticize the scientific bureaucracy, and scientists themselves, for claims about global warming that he views as unfounded and alarmist. His detractors can't dismiss him as a crank from the fringe, however, much as they might wish. Dr. Lindzen is a critic from within, one of the most distinguished climate scientists in the world: a past professor at the University of Chicago and Harvard, the Alfred P. Sloan professor of meteorology at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, a member of the National Academy of Sciences, and a lead author in a landmark report from the United Nations' Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, the very organization that established global warming as an issue of paramount importance.

Dr. Lindzen's description of the conditions under which the climate scientists worked conjures up a scene worthy of a totalitarian state: "throughout the drafting sessions, IPCC 'coordinators' would go around insisting that criticism of models be toned down, and that 'motherhood' statements be inserted to the effect that models might still be correct despite the cited faults. Refusals were

occasionally met with ad hominem attacks. I personally witnessed coauthors forced to assert their 'green' credentials in defense of their statements.”

There are hundreds, if not thousands, of other credentialed climatologists who disagree with those in Al Gore's camp but unfortunately you will rarely hear their views made public by the “green friendly” media. Research both sides and determine for yourself who to believe.

Time for some good news... thank goodness someone is finally standing up to the biggest bully this country has ever known. For years I have been writing and warning the American public about the true agenda of one of our country's greatest enemies within, the ACLU (American Civil Liberties Union.)
