Enemy of the State

Recent United States Supreme Court decisions, i.e., *Kelo v. New London*, allowing local government to take property through eminent domain and transfer it to other private owners; and the Yes/No???? *Ten Commandments* conundrum; should come as no surprise to those who have been watching the road signs along the pock marked freedom highway of these United States over the last several decades. Among his friends, in addition to notable and powerful Americans, he was proud to be closely associated and counted as one of his heroes some foreign leaders. One that was at the top of his list was the man who fathered the belief that Capitalism should evolve into Socialism and ultimately Communism, Karl Marx. Of course we called his "ism" Marxism.

Maybe you're aware of one of Marx's famous quotes... "*Democracy is the road to Socialism.*" Of course some of his other statements should clue you in to attacks in today's society on religious freedoms and the recent Supreme Court decisions mentioned above. They are:

1- "*The social principles of Christianity preach cowardice, self-contempt, abasement, submission, humility... in a word all the qualities of the canaille (the rabble.)*"; 2- "*The first requisite for the happiness of the people is the abolishment of religion;*" 3- "*Religion is the opium of the masses;*" 4- "*The theory of Communism may be summed up in one sentence... Abolish all private property.*"

Does all the above sound familiar? It should... it's what's been happening in the good ole' USA for the last 40 or 50 years. And helping to speed this evolvment along was our American hero... figured out who he was yet?

Our man was born in the late 1800s and in spite of being born to a wealthy New England family he grew to hate his wealth and strived to have socialism become the law of the land. He was also a fanatical anti-war person and spent time in prison for blatantly disregarding his call from the Selective Service Bureau. He formed an organization for the protection and encouragement of anyone who chose to fight the draft and was charged by the Federal Government with seditious activities, particularly undermining United States war efforts during World War I.

It was during and shortly after this time that he became enamored with the Socialistic upheaval taking place in Russia and had dreams of the same type revolution in America. He visited the Soviet Union in 1927 and became so captivated by the Communist credo that he wrote a book entitled "Liberty under the Soviets," wherein he let it be known that he viewed the Soviet Union as a "super-progressive" state. Even though his front for existence in the United States was the protection of suppressed workers and individuals, his total philosophy apparently had a double standard where the Soviet Union was involved. He wrote, "*Such an attitude as I express toward the relation of economic to civil liberty may easily be construed as condoning in Russia repressions which I condemn in Capitalist countries. It is true that I feel differently about them, because they are unlike. Repressions in Western Democracies are violations of professed constitutional liberties, and I condemn them as such. Repressions in Soviet Russia are the weapons of struggle in a transition period to Socialism.*"

His writings in a periodical headquartered in New York City, entitled "Soviet Russia Today" re-emphasized his feelings... "*When the power of the working class is once achieved, as it has been only in the Soviet Union, I am for maintaining it by any means whatever... No champion of a Socialist society could fail to see that some suppression was necessary to achieve it.*" Another quote from his writings should make normal thinking people sit up and take notice, but strangely it finds a home on the left these days.

"I am for socialism, disarmament, and, ultimately, for abolishing the state itself... I seek the social ownership of property, the abolition of the propertied class, and the sole control of those who produce wealth. Communism is the goal."

After being hounded by the government for his subversive activities our Communist mole changed the name of his organization and also changed his tactics of operation. He wrote to a Socialist friend of the day, Louis Lochner this revealing agenda...

"We want to look like patriots in everything we do. We want to get a lot of flags, talk a great deal about the Constitution and what our forefathers wanted to make of this country and to show that we are the fellows that really stand for the spirit of our institutions."

By now, I hope you recognize the organization our friend began even if you don't know his name. Roger Nash Baldwin was our interloper's name and the American Civil Liberties Union is the Communist, Socialistic organization he founded. Is it a coincidence the liberal left of our great country seek the same goals Mr. Baldwin did or is there a closer connection somehow? How long will we allow this to go on?
